- 3. Posters

- Analysis and written production of academic and professional genres
- Research methodologies in reading and writing
- Instruction and assessment in reading and writing
- The relationship between reading and writing in higher education and other educational levels
- Oral communication in academic and professional contexts

The thematic areas correspond to the development axes promoted by the Association. Presentations are expected to correspond to research (ongoing or completed) and report data-based results.

#### SUBMISSION NORMS

All abstracts, in all three modalities, must contain title, author(s) name, and name and acronym of the institution. The length should be between 400 and 600 words (including references). The abstract should include objective(s), theoretical framework, methodology, results, and conclusions of the study.
